The minimum requirements for Standard Operating Procedures during the COVID-19 pandemic are as follows:

- 1. Hand Sanitizing Station at entrance
- 2. One-way traffic flow by placing signage on floor and walls
- Limiting the number of customers in store to maintain 2-meter physical distancing
- 4. Plexiglass (barrier) installed at Point of Sale (POS)
- 5. Tap payments are preferred
- 6. Covering POS keypad with clear wrap
- 7. Disinfecting commonly touched areas including staff lounging area
- 8. Proper disposal of masks and gloves

NOTE: Masks are only required when physical distancing can not be maintained. If a customer is refusing to maintain 2-meters, it is at the stores discretion to either require the patron to wear a mask or refuse service.

Do you have any of the following symptoms?

- Fever
- New onset of cough
- Worsened chronic cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Difficulty swallowing
- Decrease of loss of sense of taste or smell
- Chills
- Headaches
- Unexplained fatigue / malaise / muscle aches (myalgias)
- Nausea / vomiting / diarrhea / abdominal pain
- Pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- Runny nose or nasal congestion Without other no one cause

Have you traveled outside of the northeast region in the past 14 days?

Have you tested positive for COVID-19 or had close contact with a case of COVID-19 without wearing appropriate PPE?

If you have answered <u>"YES"</u> to any of these questions, <u>PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE STORE</u>, we recommend getting tested for COVID-19.
